- This meeting is held for the purpose of discussing the **business of the Association** properly brought before an Annual General Meeting and will follow the Agenda circulated to the Members. *Issues of a personal nature*will not be debated or considered.
- Only Members and invited guests will be entitled to attend the meeting.
- All Members will practice fairness, courteous and respectful communication at all times.
- Members who wish to ask a question may do so through the Q & A **chat function** available through Zoom. The Chair of the meeting will determine who among the Board is best suited to answer any question.

- > Only one item, the immediately pending Agenda item and/or the matter under discussion will be considered at a time.
- Although everyone may ask up to two questions on the same matter, a question from a Member that has not yet posed a question will be given preference over a Member who has already asked a question.
- The Board will endeavour to answer as many questions as time permits, but may not be able to answer every question and may opt not to answer a question that they believe has already been asked and answered.
- No Members' proposals having been received by the Association in accordance with Section 81 of the Societies Act, only motions listed on the Agenda will be considered at the meeting.
- Elections <u>if required</u> for the vacant board positions will be conducted electronically via the third party on-line voting tool known as Electionbuddy. Details of the voting process will be communicated to all Members via email and be posted on the Association's website. The results will be communicated in the same method.





This scholarship is awarded annually in memory of the late Bruce Allison of Richmond, 26th president of BC Hockey.



TREASURER'S REPORT

At the start of the season 2021-2022, we were still in middle of the Year 2 of the pandemic. Although some of the restrictions were lifted and games were resumed, some costs associated with the COVID-19 safety measures were still lingering. However, in 2021-2022, we have experienced minor growth with our registration as many families felt more comfortable and saw the needs for physical activities for their children. Hopefully, this trend will continue in 2022-2023. Also, RJMHA had resumed fundraising activities such as silent auction and our board members were able to engage to our sponsors which reduced the some of the overall financial impacts.

Overall, RJMHA incurred a deficit of \$107,000 which was absorbed with our cash in the account. By the fiscal end of 2021-2022, RJMHA's cash position is at approximately \$220,000. This loss was due to the following:

- Due to the December PHO restriction, two tournaments Holiday C and Richmond International Bantam and Midget (RIBMT) were impacted. Holiday C needed to be restructured into 3 days tournament instead of 4 day tournaments and 6 teams withdrew. RIBMT had 35 teams registered and was cancelled. We suffered from the loss of revenue and incurred additional unrecoverable expenses. (~\$56,000)
- Additional COVID-19 surcharges on the ice rental expense. (~\$15,000)
- Skill providers cost has increased. (~\$26,000)

Looking forward to the season of 2022-2023, we are optimistic that our registration will continue to grow and we should have a closer to "normal" season. Last and not least, RJMHA is grateful to have the supports from all the parent volunteers and coaches throughout the season. Our volunteers have kept our cost low and affordable for our kids to enjoy the sports they love.

BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

2. DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS


The Society is incorporated under the Society Act of British Columbia and was established on February 6, 2018 and commenced operations on April 1, 2018. The Society was formed by the merger of Richmond Minor Hockey Association with Seafair Minor Hockey Association for the purpose of strengthening the stewardship of hockey in the city of Richmond.

The Society is exempt from income taxes under the Income Tax Act of Canada.



RJMHA 2021-22 **OPERATING BUDGET 2022-23**





RJMHA 2021-22 **VOLUNTEER DEPOSIT/FEE**



In order to ensure the continued success of the many programs that Richmond Jets MHA runs each year, we are implementing a mandatory Volunteer commitment and deposit for each family of a child registered with RJMHA (with the exception of players in the Juvenile Division).

Deposit Information:

- Each family participating in the program (who did not opt out at the beginning of the season \$300 fee) will provide a \$200 post-dated deposit cheque per player to a cap of \$300 for families, dated March 15, 2023 and made out to RJMHA. Juvenile aged players are exempt from the volunteer deposit.
- ➤ Cheques will be collected by the division manager during the A tryouts and C evaluation skates for your player (s) (please bring to each player's first scheduled skate)

Volunteer Requirements:

- Each family will need to volunteer for a minimum of 5 shifts/credits for each child or commit to one full time position with their child's team for each child registered with RJMHA.
- Families with 2 or more children registered will need to complete a minimum of 8 shifts/credits or commit to one full time position with their child's team
- Positions will be listed on the website and tracked by team managers. Shift times will vary depending on the responsibilities, but will generally be 1-1.5 hours in length

(Example – Joan has 3 children registered with RJMHA. She can meet her volunteer commitment by signing up for 8 shifts/credits or by committing to an Assistant Coach position with her child's team)

Families must complete **all assigned shifts** or complete the duties of the full-time position in order to meet the volunteer commitment.
