Key Responsibilities:

Programming Curriculum, Implementation and Maintenance

- Provide Jets coaches and Skills Coaches with the development plan to ensure cohesion and proper learning progressions throughout the season

Coach Recruitment and Mentorship

- Recruit, manage and develop coaches in all divisions in conjunction with the Director of Rep Hockey and Coach Committee
- Conduct monthly off-ice coach development sessions with all C Division coaches (and assistant coaches) throughout the season
- Provide any on/off ice support to Jets coaches throughout the season
- Conduct coach interviews and performance reviews in collaboration with the Director of Rep and C Coach coordinator.

Team Visits / Skill Coach Visits

- Visit C program Team practices and/or games throughout the season to create relationships with the players/coaches, observe and provide feedback to the coaches/team
- Prioritize the newer, “less experienced” coaches, to teach them how to effectively manage games, create practice plans and execute drills.

Day-To-Day On-Ice Hockey Operations Management

- Be present at the rink and manage the daily on-ice hockey program, mainly focusing on the U7-U18 C Program. This includes running Skills Sessions, training skills support coaches and coach mentorship initiatives.
- Provide support to Rep Director when required.
- Work closely with the management team, coaches, volunteers and members

Rep Tryouts

- Oversee and execute the rep tryout and team selection process in conjunction with the Director of Rep, Rep Committee, Executive Director, evaluators, coaches and volunteers

- Coach Them is an online platform used to maximize our on ice session by decreasing the time spent at the board during practice.
- Coach Them will allow our association coaches/skill providers to create a database of skills, drills and practice plans that will be at the fingertips of our association coaches; giving them access to the tools they need to develop as a coach.
- Coach Them has an existing library of thousands of drills and practice plans; setting our inexperienced and experienced coaches up for success.

U7/U9 New Pathway Model

- Largely participated/lead the development of PCAHA new policy/pathway of our U7/U9 development model.
- Collaborated with other association directors to provide the guidelines of the evaluation process as well as in-season guidelines to roll out this new program within PCAHA.
- Executed the U7/U9 Major/Minor player assessments process and player placement within the Major and Minor divisions.

Skills Programming Curriculum

- Developed a seasonal Skill Development Plan (blueprint/curriculum) specific to each age group, division and level. Oversaw the planning, delivery and direction for this plan to be carried out by our skill provider staff.
- Developed a program with proper progressions to allow our skill coaches to work effectively in unison and deliver a program to the players that gives them the best opportunity to improve and progress their overall skill level, understanding of the game, and enjoyment of the game.
- Added Opt-in programming to our skill curriculum such as defence specific training, power skating, U15/U18C Skills Program, extra goalie development/scoring situations; these programs are dependent on ice availability.

Coach Mentorship Program

- Developed a 5 series (monthly) coach seminar program to aid in the development of our association coaches from U7-U13C programming. The series included:
