Annual General Meeting Minutes 2023

7:00 pm, June 1, 2023 - Zoom Video Conferencing

The meeting was chaired by Trent Gustafson – Vice President

2. **Introduction and opening remarks by AGM Chair** – Trent Gustafson

5. **Approval of 2021 AGM Minutes:**
Motion to approve 2022 AGM (June 1, 2022) Meeting Minutes;

6. **Annual Reports:** (refer to all reports on the RJMHA website)
 1. **Volunteer Recognition** – Volunteer Recognition was presented by Executive Director, Wayne Carleton.
 2. **Scholarship Committee** – RJMHA Graduating Scholarships, and PCAHA Awards were presented by Executive Director, Wayne Carleton.
 3. **Finance Committee: Madeleine Lau RJMHA Treasurer**
 - Presentation of Finance and Audit committee report and Financial Statements for year ending March 31, 2023. Overall, RJMHA bounced back from our deficit to net revenue of \$187,000 this year and a cash position of \$387,000. This is mainly due to significant increase in tournament revenues, revenues for pre-season and opt-in programs, bank interest revenues, volunteer opt-in revenues and reduction in ice costs.
 - Reviewed operating budget for 2023-24 using pie charts for revenues and expenses, based on normal gaming grant being received. (\$175,000). Also reviewed registration fees, showed comparison chart and the cost per sessions for U13C and U18C players.
 - There were no questions asked about financial documents.

- A member brought forward a motion to amend the Bylaw amendments as presented, to only include members that can be added to the Board of Directors and not non-members as stated in the amendments for Par 8.3 and 8.9.
- **Motion to amend the Bylaw Amendments and remove Part 8.3 "that are non-members" and Part 8.9 "and such directors need not be members" as presented;**
- **Moved by Tod McPherson, Seconded by Jason Light, carried.**
- No further questions were brought forward. A motion to approve the Special Resolution was presented and the Poll Feature was used.
- **Motion to approve the Bylaw Amendments as presented to include the passed amendment to the Special Resolution, to only include members to be appointed to the board if there are not 11 Directors;**
- **Moved by Madeleine Lau, Seconded by Paul McGinley, carried (86% in favor).**

Each candidate was given a few minutes to introduce themselves.

9. New Business & Related Questions:

The following questions were brought forward and addressed by Trent Gustafson and members of the Board present at the meeting:

1. Rink Closures Updates – RIC Forum and Gardens?

- Trent Gustafson provided an update and indicated that the City has said construction is on time and to please refer to the communication to members issued in May.
- We are looking at our options and will be better to provide updates after we get the Sept. interim schedule in the summer.
- The board is looking at acquiring ice and the Oval and also outside of Richmond (Planet Ice Delta) to supplement any loss of ice that all divisions would [possibly utilized and also, we may need to make more use of morning ice available and share ice for practices.

2. Will there be skills sessions for U15C and U18C?

- Trent said that is something the programming committee can investigate and if we did run skills, it would most likely be opt-in. In previous years we did try to run skills for these divisions and the attendance was very poor and it was removed from the program.

3. Will there be weekly goalie skills sessions?

- Trent indicated we plan to have goalie skills again that will include group and team sessions as we have done this past year.

4. For rep tryouts, will we set rosters for the lower teams (A3 and A4) sooner this year?

- We are always looking to improve the rep tryout process and realize it does take time to create rosters for the lower teams as they need to wait for releases from A1 and A2 before making their final releases. We will look to speed up the process this year and communicate the schedule to the players and parents.

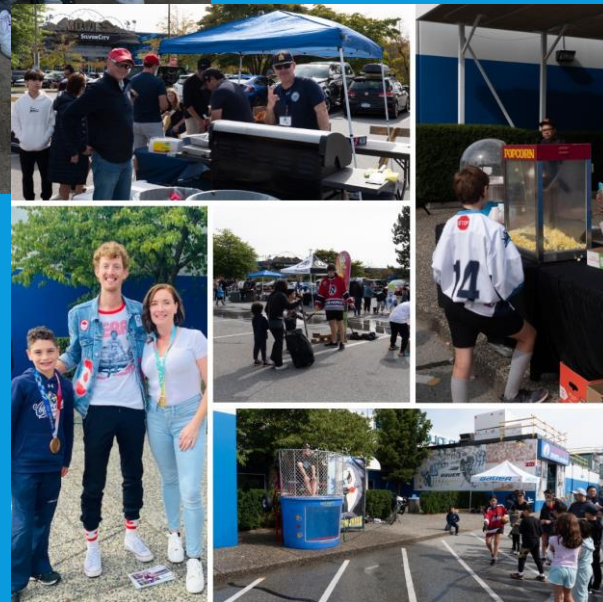

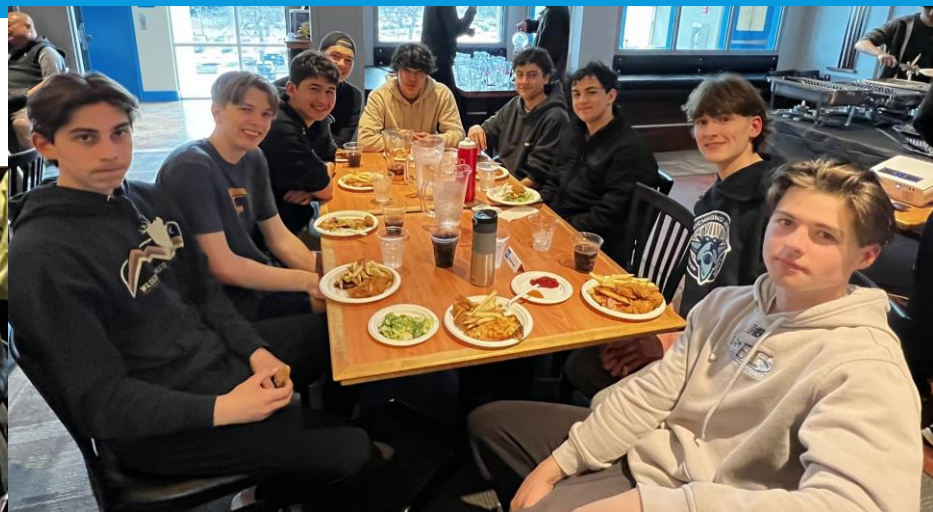

TREASURERS REPORT

Then 2023-2024 season continued to see the Richmond Jets Minor Hockey Association (RJMHA) recover from the COVID-19 pandemic, as well as ongoing repairs and maintenance to the Richmond Ice Centre. Our overall registration was the best since the 2018-2019 season, and from a financial perspective we continued to build a great program for all members.

Overall, we finished the season with an excess of revenue over expenses of \$129K. Registration and fees for pre-season and in-season camps continued to show significant growth along with tournaments. Some of the highlights include:

REVENUE

- Overall Revenue 2% higher than budget, and 11% higher than previous year.
- Registration fees - \$700K collected. On target for budget, and 1% higher than 2022
- Pre-Season & In-Season skills camps all very well attended and much higher than forecasted.
- Tournaments – approximately 20% increase over previous year.

EXPENSES

- Ice Rental 8% higher than previous year associated with renting ice at Planet Ice Delta due to construction on Forum & Gardens in Sept/Oct
- Instructor Fees 10% higher than forecast due to additional positions for Rep Director and additional evaluation costs for U7-U13.

In addition to the operations for the season, RJMHA purchased game jerseys for U9 teams in the amount of \$14K and will also purchase game jerseys for all U7 teams this coming season. This will enhance the RJMHA brand and allow the younger age groups to feel as they are part of the overall organization.

For the 2024-2025 season, we are committed to maintain registration fees at current levels and will endeavour to lower costs where feasible. We are grateful to have the support of all the parent volunteers and coaches throughout the season.

1. DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS

The Society is incorporated under the Society Act of British Columbia and was established on February 6, 2018 and commenced operations on April 1, 2018. The Society was formed by the merger of Richmond Minor Hockey Association with Seafair Minor Hockey Association for the purpose of strengthening the stewardship of hockey in the city of Richmond.

The Society is exempt from income taxes under the Income Tax Act of Canada.

2. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of Richmond Jets Minor Hockey Association as at March 31, 2024, and the statements of revenues and expenditures and changes in net assets for the year then ended is on the historical cost basis and reflects cash transactions with the addition of:

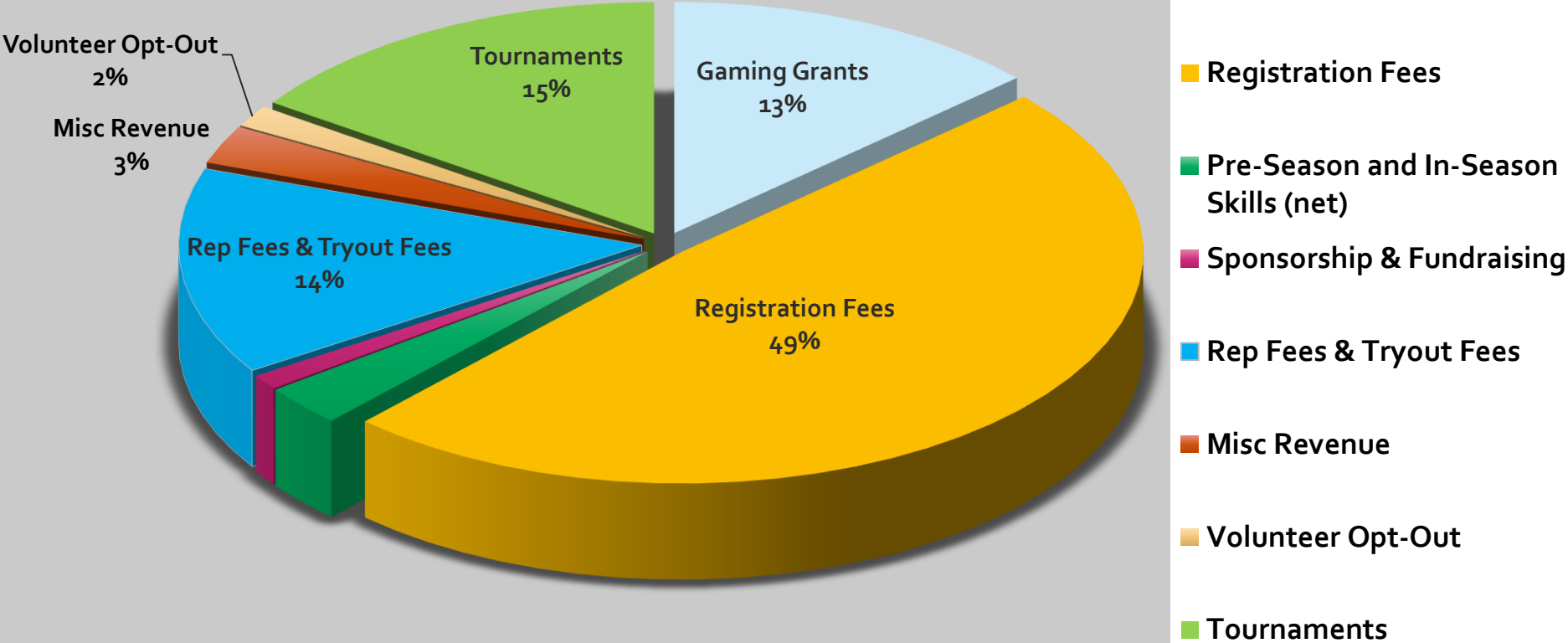

2024/2025 BUDGET - PROJECTED REVENUE



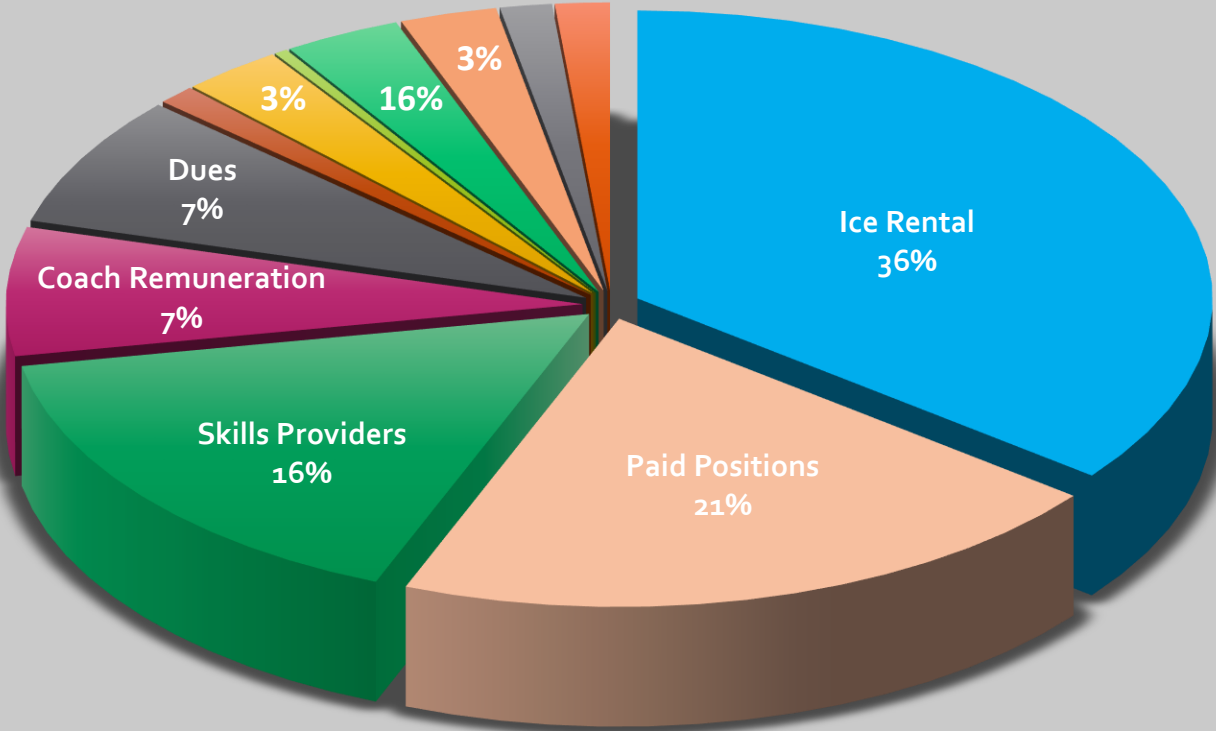

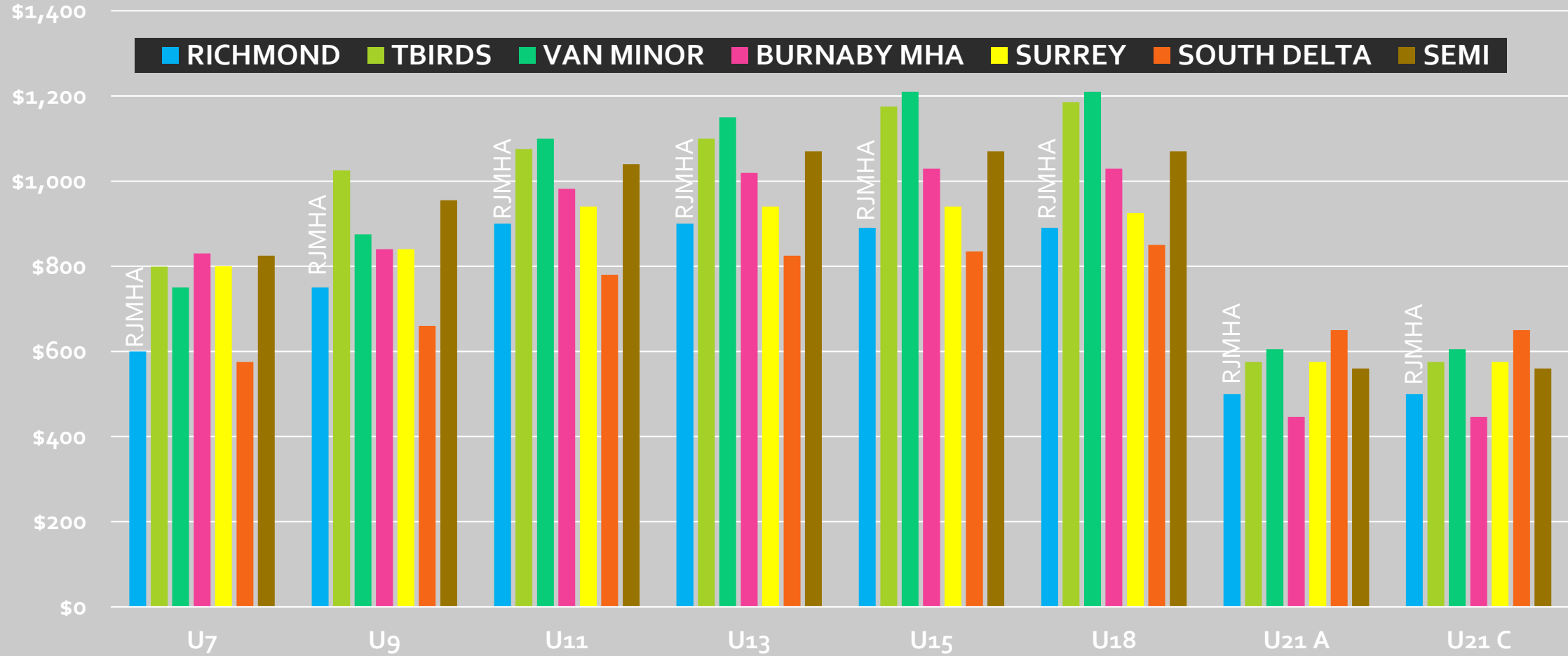

AGM 2024 – BOARD ELECTIONS



Voting eligibility is set out in Section 7 of the Association's Bylaws

As per the new Bylaws approved at the 2021 AGM, the Board of Directors consists of 7-11 directors including the President.

Eight (8) directors will be returning for their second term – **Trent Gustafson (VP), Hanif Hamir (Treasurer), Madeleine Lau, Mark Rustia, Michael Starchuk, Kate Chan, Steven Yip, and Gonzalo Del Castillo.** The remaining vacancies result from the current President, **Eric Bernal** moving to the Past President position and Directors – **Henry Han** and **Paul McGinley**, completing their two-year terms.

2024 ELECTIONS – VOTING PROCEDURES



9.1 Nomination of Directors

Nominations for election as a Director must be made in accordance with the Bylaws, and such policies and procedures as are established by the Board from time to time. All nominations are subject to the following rules:

- (a) a nomination must be made in writing, in a form established by the Association;
- (b) a nominee must be a Member in good standing to be nominated and must remain in good standing in order to stand for election;
- (c) a Member may nominate him or herself, and the nomination must be signed by the Member nominated and one (1) other Member in good standing;
- (d) a Member may not nominate more nominees than the number of Director positions available for election;
- (e) nominations must be submitted in advance of an election, in accordance with such deadlines as may be established by the Board; and
- (f) nominations will not be permitted from the floor at a General Meeting.

7.4 Voting Methods

Voting by Members may occur by any one or more of the following methods, in the discretion of the Board:

- a) by show of hands or voting cards;
- b) by written ballot; or
- c) by vote conducted by Electronic Means.**

ElectionBuddy is an online voting platform that provides secure and reliable solutions for conducting elections, particularly for organizations, businesses, associations, and other groups that require a robust and trusted voting system.

Voting Procedures:

- All ordinary members in good standing, 19 years of age or older (player U21, parent of a player), based on emails provided at registration for the 2023-24 season, head coaches and assistant coaches who do not have a child in the association and life members, will be sent an email on the voting procedures on Thursday June 6th and voting will open at 6PM on June 6th and run until Sunday June 9th at 9PM. Results will be announced on June 10th.
- At that time, the system will tally the votes and provide the results to Eric Bernal – President and Wayne Carleton - Executive Director.
- The results will be communicated to the members via email and posted on our website and social media platforms.
- In the event there is a tie a second vote will be required, which will be communicated to the members.
