Main Objectives:

- Develop and implement programs to enhance players' skills and sportsmanship.
- Increase player, coach and volunteer engagement and satisfaction.
- Foster a safe and inclusive environment for all participants.
- Continue to offer an affordable hockey experience and financial stability.
- Strive to be one of the top minor hockey associations in the province, with a program offering that is second to none.

Key Responsibilities:

- ➤ **Operations** Oversee the day-to-day operations of the association working directly with the Executive Committee, Board, the management team, appointed positions, volunteers, coaches and skills providers;
- ➤ **Communication** Strong communication, whether it be in-person, virtual, social media, email and TeamSnap platforms. Engage with volunteers, coaches and members and at association events (Opening Day, Tournaments, Try Hockey, Awards Nights). Organize and execute surveys year end, U7/U9 program, goalies and referees.
- ➤ **Governance/Leadership:** Work directly with the Executive Team to improve the RJMHA governance model. Worked with the numerous standing and special committees along with reviewing and updating our bylaws and policies as required. Organizing, planning and attending monthly board meetings and completing reports and taking meetingminutes;
- Financial/Budgetary: Worked closely with the treasurer and finance committee. Responsible for assisting with monthly and yearly operating budgets. Processed monthly invoices for skills providers and appointed positions and kept track of budgets;

- ➤ **Recreational C & U7/U9 Programs:** Worked with division managers and the director of hockey in the planning and execution of the C program;
- ➤ **Rep Program:** Worked with the director of rep and rep committee and helped organize and manage the rep tryout process. Updated policies as required and provided direction throughout the year. Planned and organized the Rep ID Skates and U9 Intro To Rep Hockey skates and parent meetings;
- ➤ **Risk Management & Safety:** Worked directly with the risk manager, division managers and division ambassadors on dispute resolution and discipline issues. Dealt with allegations and maltreatment issues from PCAHA and BC Hockey;
- ➤ **Programming:** Member of the program committee and worked with Director of Hockey and Ice Allocator on the execution and management of the skills and opt-in programs;
- ➤ **Pre-Season Camps & Programs:** Planned, organized and executed summer camps in July (power skating) and August (season prep camps). Also helped organize the Try Hockey and Try Goalie skates in August and the Ready to Launch program;
- ➤ **PCAHA/BC Hockey:** Attended monthly PCAHA President C League meetings, PCAHA AGM's (2), president caucus meetings, monthly noon hour meeting and was a member of PCAHA U17 pilot program committee;
- ➤ **Coach Mentorship:** Worked with the DOHO and DOR on setting up monthly meetings, and distributed presentations.

2024/2025 Season Summary:

Continue to develop a better culture and the "Jets Way" throughout the association, following a set of guiding principles for all our players and coaches in accordance with our Mission, Vision and Values. It is very important that we continue to work on developing a strong culture that is inclusive, accessible and affordable to make community hockey the choice of many in Richmond.
