SUBJECT: **Scorekeeping Mentors - New for 2026-2027.**

Ongoing issues with scorekeeping errors and the quality of electronic gamesheets have been a matter of concern for several years. These issues were examined during 2025-2026 by the Scorekeeping Working Group.

The Working Group believes PCAHA and its member Minor Hockey Associations should take greater ownership of the off-ice official positions and move towards a greater emphasis on training and quality standards for electronic scorekeeping. It recommended that each team identify "Scorekeeping Mentors", who would be responsible to mentor and assist the team's parent scorekeepers in mastering game data entry in Spordle Play and ensure greater accuracy of electronic gamesheet submissions.

The Working Group's proposal was adopted with amendments at the PCAHA AGM on Sunday, May 31, 2026, as follows:

Teams in the U11-U21 divisions shall provide the name of at least one Scorekeeping Mentor (SM) before the start of league play to their League Manager. These team representative(s):

- (a) Will be required to register for and attend all PCAHA E-Gamesheet training sessions. Completion of the training sessions will be recorded in the HCR.
- (b) Will be the team support people for helping other parents.
- (c) Should not be the Team Manager.
- (d) Are not required to sit in the scorekeeper box during the game (unless it is their own shift in the rotation).

In addition, all parents with a player on a U9 and/or U11 team must view the E-Gamesheet Basics Video.

In the case of frequent errors or omissions by a team, upon the third time a gamesheet is submitted by a team with errors or omissions, the Managing Director will notify the Association President.

Scorekeeping Mentors will not be registered on the team roster in HCR unless they hold other team official positions. They will become a point of contact in addressing scorekeeping errors.

Please ensure that team officials within your Association are aware of this new team position and are prepared to begin identifying persons who can undertake the Scorekeeping Mentor role.
