Annual General Meeting Minutes 2025

7:00 pm, June 4, 2025 - Zoom Video Conferencing

The meeting was chaired by Hanif Hamir - Treasurer

1. **Welcome and call to order, 7:05pm** – Hanif Hamir
2. **Introduction and opening remarks by AGM Chair** – Hanif Hamir
3. **Establish quorum and review meeting rules** – Quorum established – **29 members in attendance.**
4. **Review Agenda** – Agenda reviewed, no addition to the agenda.
Motion to approve 2025 AGM Agenda:
Moved by Gonzalo Del Castillo, Seconded by Theodora Groumoutis, carried.
5. **Approval of 2024 AGM Minutes:**
Motion to approve 2024 AGM (June 5, 2024) Meeting Minutes;
Moved by Theodora Groumoutis, Seconded by Kate Chan, carried.
6. **Annual Reports:** (refer to all reports on the RJMHA website)
 1. **Volunteer Recognition** – Volunteer Recognition was presented by Director Kate Chan.
 2. **Scholarship Committee** – RJMHA Graduating Scholarships, PCAHA and BC Hockey scholarships were presented by Director – Madeleine Lau. There were 17 recipients this year and 1 PCAHA scholarship awarded. Director Kate Chan discussed the U18 Grad Game & Events. There were 47 graduating players this year.
 3. **Finance Committee: Presented by Hanif Hamir RJMHA Treasurer**
 - Presentation of Finance and Audit committee report and Financial Statements for year ending March 31, 2025.
 - Overall, we finished the season with an excess of revenue over expenses of just over \$39,000.00. Registration and fees for pre-season and in-season camps continued to show significant growth along with tournaments. Some of the highlights include:
REVENUE:
 - Overall Revenue 2% higher than 2024.
 - Registration fees – Just under \$700K collected which was slightly over the budgeted amount.

- Pre-Season & In-Season skills camps all very well attended and much higher revenues than forecasted.

EXPENSES

- Ice Rental 7% higher than previous year associated with increase in ice costs.
- Instructor Fees about 9% higher than forecast due to having more teams resulting in more skills programs.

- Reviewed operating budget for 2025-26 using pie charts for revenues and expenses, based on normal gaming grant being received of \$175,000. We are projecting a break-even budget this year. Hanif also reviewed registration fees, showed comparison chart and the cost per sessions for U13C and U18C players. For the third year in a row, we will be keeping fees frozen for all divisions and the Jets still have the lowest fees in the PCAHA compared to other Vancouver area associations.

7. Election of Directors for 2025 - 2027:

- Executive Director, Wayne Carleton reviewed the nomination process, and the retiring and returning directors:
 - Retiring directors **Kate Chan, Steven Yip** and **Michael Starchuk** were recognized and thanked for their service.
 - Returning directors include: **Charmaine Schmaltz, Henry Han** and **Adam Blanchette**.
- The candidates for Director positions were presented and the following nominations (7) were confirmed prior to the AGM per the RJMHA bylaws – **Trent Gustafson, Madeleine Lau, Hanif Hamir, Gonzalo Del Castillo** and **Mark Rustia, were seeking re-election and there were 2 new candidates, Julie Bauer and Randy Sandhu.**
- The election process was reviewed and the candidates were elected via **acclamation** in accordance with our bylaws, as there were 8 directors' positions available and only 7 candidates.

8. New Business & Related Questions:

The following questions were brought forward and addressed by Hanif Hamir and members of the Board present at the meeting:

1. Will new jerseys be purchased for U18 to replace damaged jerseys??

- Hanif Hamir indicated that there will be new jerseys purchased to replace some of the damaged jerseys and some of the U21 extra jerseys will also be used. They are in the process of doing an inventory.

TREASURERS REPORT

The 2025-2026 season was another successful year for the Richmond Jets Minor Hockey Association (RJMHA). The association continues to put forth a program with great value for its members.

Overall, we finished the season with an excess of revenue over expenses of a little over \$24K. With increased cost pressures, RJMHA was able to achieve this without raising registration fees for members. Some highlights include the following:

REVENUE

- Registration & fees – up 1.6%. Pre-season & in-season skills camps continue to do well
- Tournaments – down 4%.
- Volunteer opt out fees – up 16%.

EXPENSES

- Ice Rental – on par with prior year.
- Tournament costs - down 9.2%. Primarily due to reducing operating costs.
- Hockey Fees – up 10.1%. Fees from both PCAHA and BC Hockey are rising.
- Advertising & Promotion – up 99.5%. Primarily due to larger social events (Canada Day, Opening Day, Grad Skate)

In addition to the operations for the season, RJMHA purchased shared video cameras for all Rep Teams.

For the 2026-2027 season, we will be implementing a \$40 increase to registration fees. This will help offset additional increases in ice rental, PCAHA fees and inflationary

1. DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS

The Society is incorporated under the Society Act of British Columbia and was established on February 6, 2018 and commenced operations on April 1, 2018. The Society was formed by the merger of Richmond Minor Hockey Association with Seafair Minor Hockey Association for the purpose of strengthening the stewardship of hockey in the city of Richmond.

The Society is exempt from income taxes under the Income Tax Act of Canada.

2. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

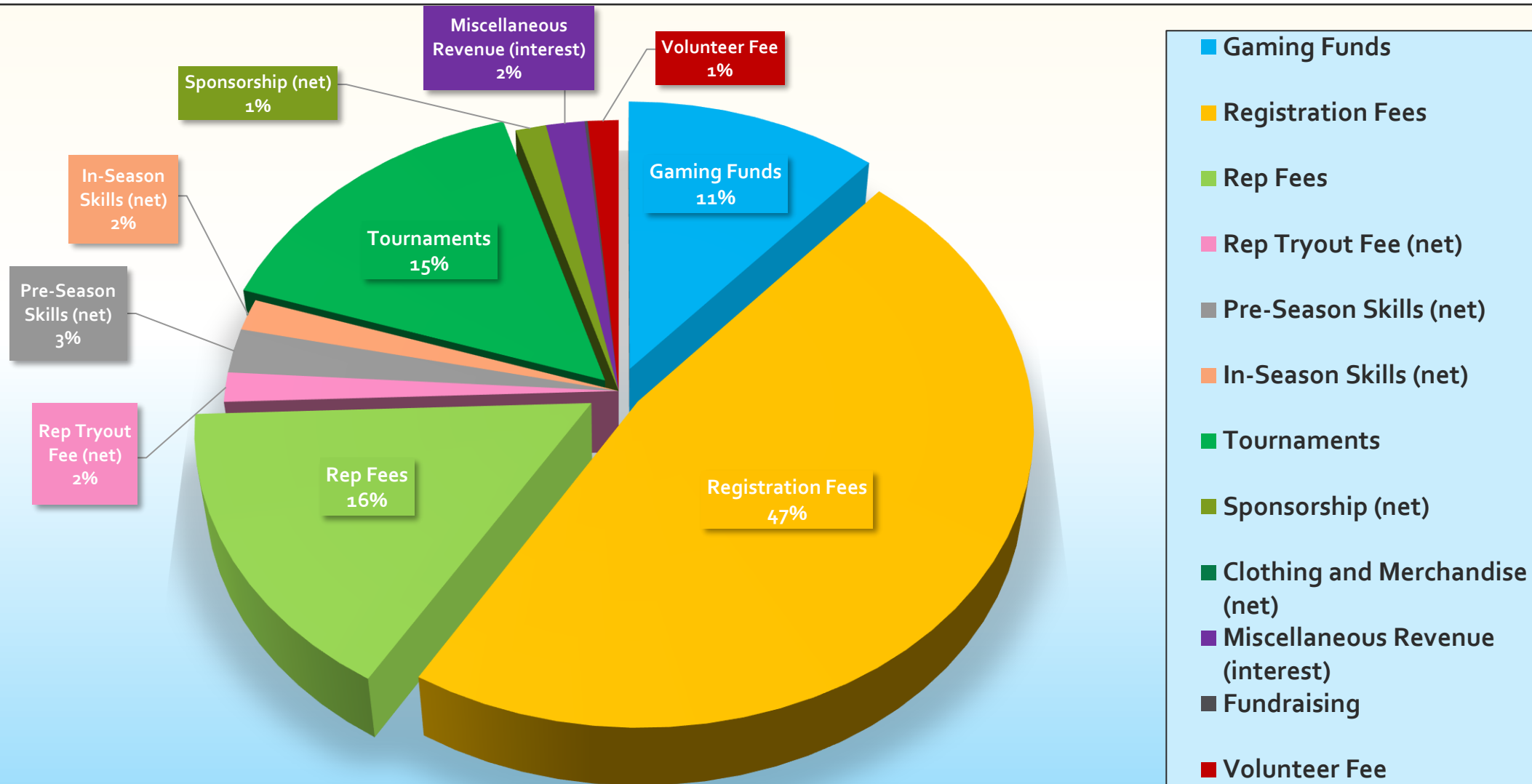

RJMHA OPERATING BUDGET 2026-27



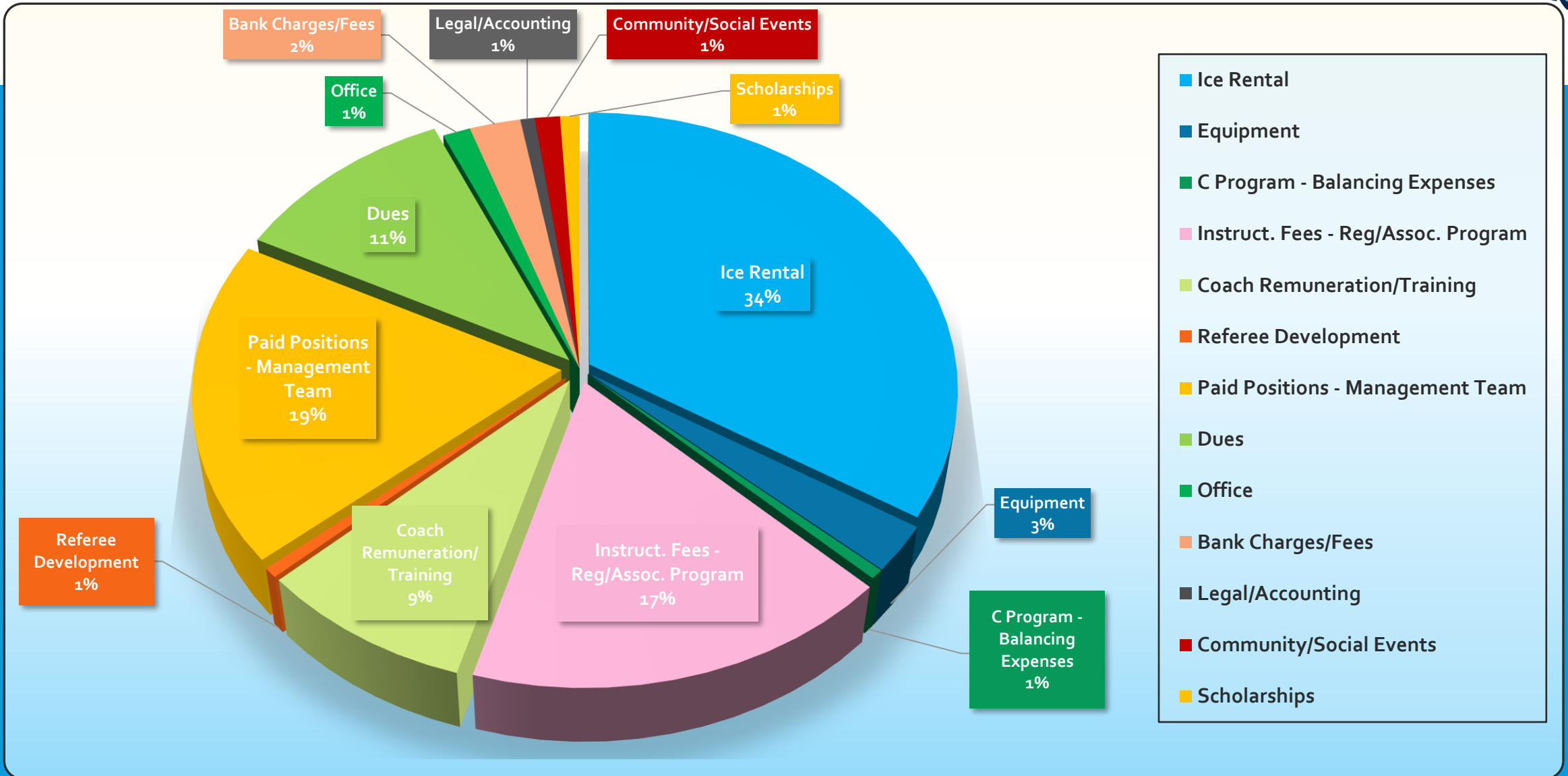
PROJECTED REVENUES

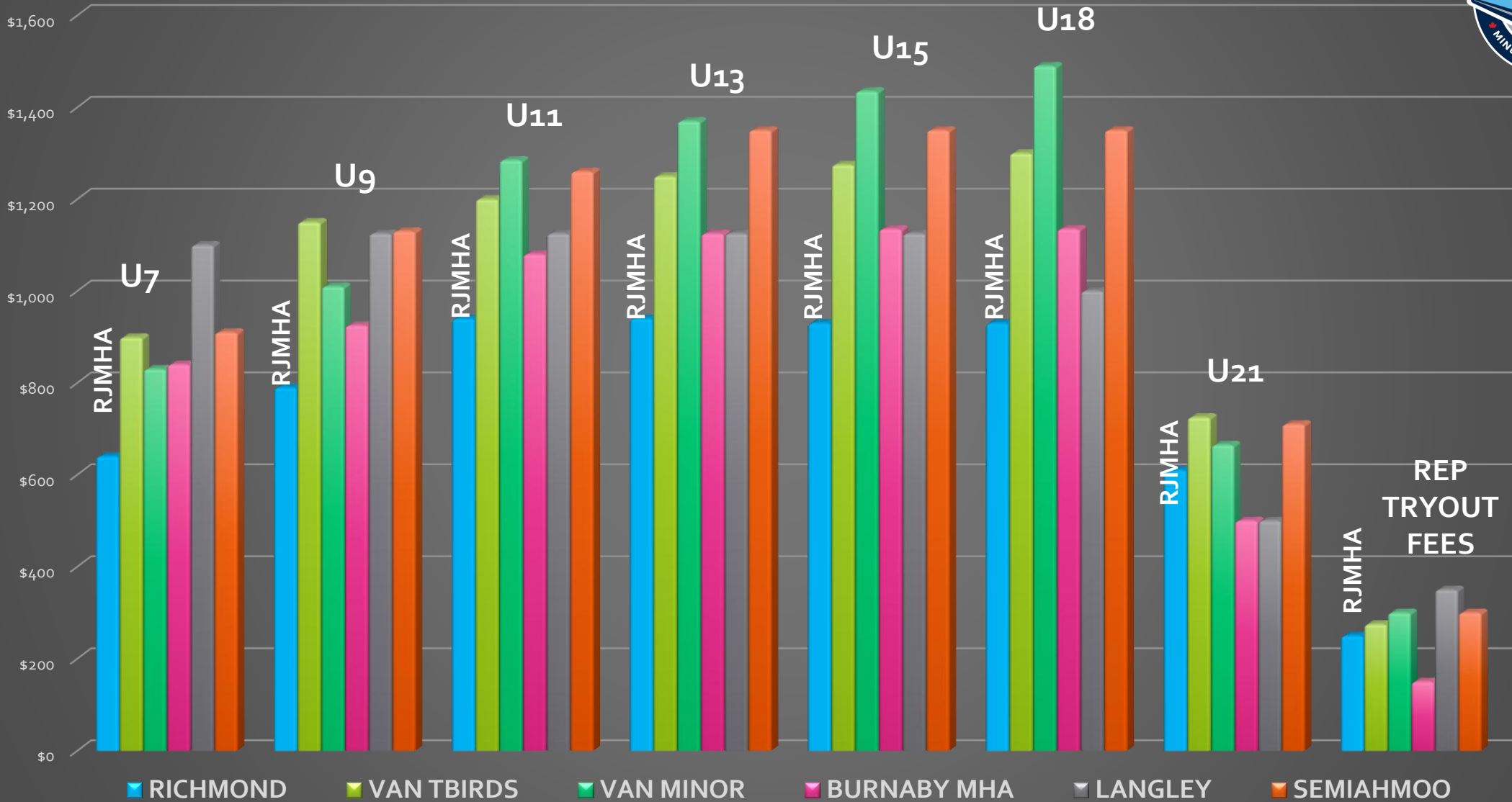

2026 ELECTIONS – VOTING PROCEDURES



9.1 Nomination of Directors:

Nominations for election as a Director must be made in accordance with the Bylaws, and such policies and procedures as are established by the Board from time to time. All nominations are subject to the following rules:

- (a) a nomination must be made in writing, in a form established by the Association;
- (b) a nominee must be a Member in good standing to be nominated and must remain in good standing in order to stand for election;
- (c) a Member may nominate him or herself, and the nomination must be signed by the Member nominated and one (1) other Member in good standing;
- (d) a Member may not nominate more nominees than the number of Director positions available for election;
- (e) nominations must be submitted in advance of an election, in accordance with such deadlines as may be established by the Board; and
- (f) nominations will not be permitted from the floor at a General Meeting.

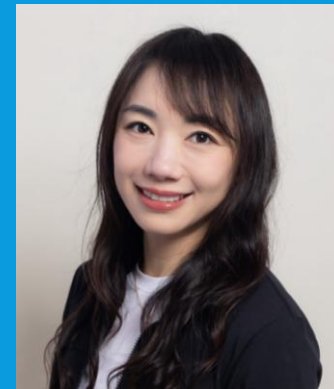

7.4 Voting Methods

Voting by Members may occur by any one or more of the following methods, in the discretion of the Board:

- a) by show of hands or voting cards;
- b) by written ballot; or
- c) **by vote conducted by Electronic Means.**

ElectionBuddy is an online voting platform that provides secure and reliable solutions for conducting elections, particularly for organizations, businesses, associations, and other groups that require a robust and trusted voting system.

Voting Procedures:

- All ordinary members in good standing, 19 years of age or older (player U21, parent of a player), based on emails provided at registration for the 2023-24 season, head coaches and assistant coaches who do not have a child in the association and life members, will be sent an email on the voting procedures on Wednesday June 3th and voting will open at 6PM and run until Sunday June 7th at 9PM. Results will be announced June 8th.
- At that time, the system will tally the votes and provide the results to Trent Gustafson – President and Wayne Carleton - Executive Director.
- The results will be communicated to the members via email and posted on our website and social media platforms.
